As a school we wholeheartedly support the Twinning Association and thank Councillor Dixon Sheppard, Chairman of the Twinning Committee for setting up a link with Mrs Tracey Meunier-Parker and Jean Mace College. We fully want to support the Twinning Association, which has been in existence for over 40 years, and endorse a long term high school exchange programme to benefit hundreds of students in both towns for many years to come. School exchange programmes and twinning has changed substantially over the years however its core principles and values remain. An exchange programme for our students will provide many excellent experiences for our young people alongside cultural and language benefits.

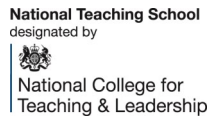
